### Stained Glass Class I - Starts Tuesday, May 13, 6:30-9:30PM

This hands-on class lasts 8 weeks. Students are expected to have no knowledge of stained glass or any previous skills or experience. The class covers glass selection, cutting, assembly in lead and copper foil along with many tips and techniques. Provides a strong foundation in stained glass and opens the way for Stained Glass Class II. Tools for the class will cost approximately \$250.00. Glass and supplies are extra. Classes must be paid for in full prior to the start of your first day in order to reserve your place. There are no refunds for classes within 2 weeks of the first day of class.

### Stained Glass Class II - Starts Tuesday, May 13, 6:30-9:30PM

This hands-on class picks up where Stained Glass I left off. It lasts 8 weeks. Students must have taken Stained Glass Class I or have knowledge in basic stained glass skills. This self guided class allows students to tap into the instructor's wealth of knowledge and take on a more advanced project. ### Fusing Class I - June 7 & 8, 9:00-4:00PM

In this two day hands-on class you will learn the fundamentals of glass fusing, slumping theory and techniques. Students will discuss design ideas and apply them to create fused pieces, slumping them into molds. You will take home several fused pieces such as bowls and vases. Students must have their own glass cutter, breaking pliers and straight edge. Glass and supplies are included. Classes must be paid for in full prior to the start of your first day in order to reserve your place. There are no refunds for classes within 2 weeks of the first day of class.

### Fusing Class II - May 17 & 18, 9:00-4:00PM

This hands-on class picks up where Fusing Class 1 left off. Instruction includes use of drop rings, sandblasting, and casting. Students must have taken the Fusing Class 1 or have the equivalent experience, have basic glass cutting skills and their own glass cutter, breaking pliers and straight edge. All supplies are included. Classes must be paid for in full prior to the start of your first day in order to reserve your place.
