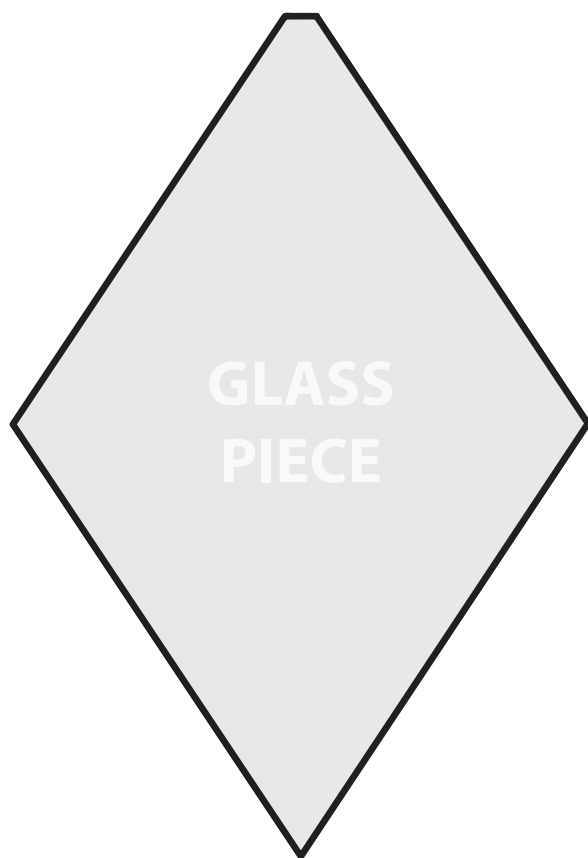


Diamond Ornament



“A great use for the extra glass that's just laying around”

STEP 1 – Cut It

Using a sheet of glass, cut out a diamond shape for each ornament you are making. We preferred using a diamond that was 3" x 4.5", but any size will do. We also found cutting off the top point helps for when you attach the hanger to it.

STEP 2 – Slump It

Place the diamonds in your kiln, and using a kiln post underneath the top and bottom to hold it up, bring the kiln up to 1200°F (depending on glass color). This will give the diamond a slightly curved appearance.

STEP 3 – Hang It

After it cools, use E6000 Glass Adhesive (no. 25E6000) to attach a Gold Jewelry Bail (no. 25LSPB) to the top back of the ornament with the loop protruding where the diamond point was cut.

Loop a matching ribbon through the bail and hang around your house.
